A Stewardship Story from Pastor Roberts

When we moved to Tennessee 15 years ago for my call to be a pastor in Knoxville, we found ourselves in a whole new phase in life. Fresh out of seminary and 4 years of low-income housing (which was a blessing to us during those years!), we were more than ready to discover all the blessings and challenges of the new state, city, and parish where God had placed us. We had never been to Tennessee before and were so excited!

We came for our first visit and immediately looked for a house to call home. Thankfully, because of generous LCMS churches and Christians throughout the United States, and because Gretchen worked full time throughout most of our seminary years, we graduated with no debt. We even had some money (a couple thousand dollars) in our seminary account to donate back in order to help another student. We had little to nothing in savings, but we experienced so much generosity that we wanted to start being generous right away out of thanks to God for all He has done for us. Going into seminary, we didn't know how we were going to pay for everything. Leaving seminary, we were amazed at how God provided beyond what we could imagine or think.

A few years into parish life and having purchased a wonderful 109-year-old home near the church, we were introduced to Nashville's famous financial coach, Dave Ramsey. We put many of Dave's principles into practice and these worked very well for us.

As taught by the Scriptures, Gretchen and I prioritize giving first and foremost towards the work of the ministry where we serve. We use a written budget and place charity/gifts at the top of our budget and determine that amount annually before all other expenses. Beyond supporting the ministry of our own congregation, we find joy in giving gifts to missions outside of the congregation, such as when Gretchen's father was serving as the resident LCMS professor in Novosibirsk, Russia; the local Pregnancy Resource Center in Maryville; and the capital campaign for a church that was very influential in my call to seminary, University Lutheran Chapel in Minneapolis.

One day, we plan to leave a generous legacy gift for the work of Christ's ministry on earth. Even as we work on that goal, we have already planned to give a sacrificial gift towards Praise's capital campaign to expand the ministry. Like other gifts of the sort, this gift will be over and above our regular giving. God has blessed us to be a blessing for this time, place, and purpose. We are doing this with you, our beloved church family, because together we are *Living Stones: Building Upon the Rock*.


